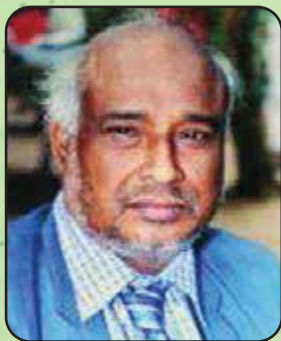

Research & Publication

Policy and Program on Research and Development

Since the University is a place for teaching and learning through research activities, Dhaka International University (DIU) is providing opportunities for research works and has set up a Research and Publication Cell for enhancement, quality assurance and assembling of research works and other publications on different subjects. In view of this objective and to monitor research programs carried out by the faculty members of different departments of DIU the following policies have been taken: (Updated policies are in the process of approval by corresponding authority).

- * A research group will consist of three faculty members for each department.
- * One will be the head of the research group and other two will be assistant researchers. More than one research group may be formed in each department.
- * Research groups will submit their research proposals to the Office of the Director, Research & Publication Cell.
- * The Supervisory Committee will scrutinize the research proposals submitted by the research groups of different departments and the selected proposals will be submitted to the authority through Advisory Committee for approval.
- * Progress reports of each research proposal have to be submitted to the Supervisory Committee on six (06) monthly basis.

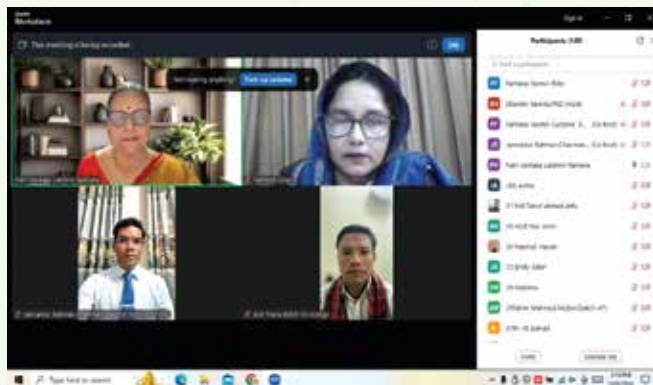
