It is now operated as a Govt. as well as UGC approved Private University under the Private University Act, 2010. Research & Publication

Policy and Program on Research and Development

Since the University is a place for teaching and learning through research activities, Dhaka International University (DIU) is providing opportunities for research works and has set up a Research and Publication Cell for enhancement, quality assurance and assembling of research works and other publications on different subjects. In view of this objective and to monitor research programs carried out by the faculty members of different departments of DIU the following policies have been taken:

- * A research group will consist of three faculty members for each department.
- * One will be head of research group and other two will be assistant researchers. More than one research group may be formed in each department.
- * Research groups will submit their research proposals to the Office of the Director, Research & Publication Cell.
- * The Supervisory Committee will scrutinize the research proposals submitted by the research groups of different departments and the selected proposals will be submitted to the authority through Advisory Committee for approval.
- * Progress reports of each research proposal have to be submitted to the Supervisory Committee on six (06) monthly basis.

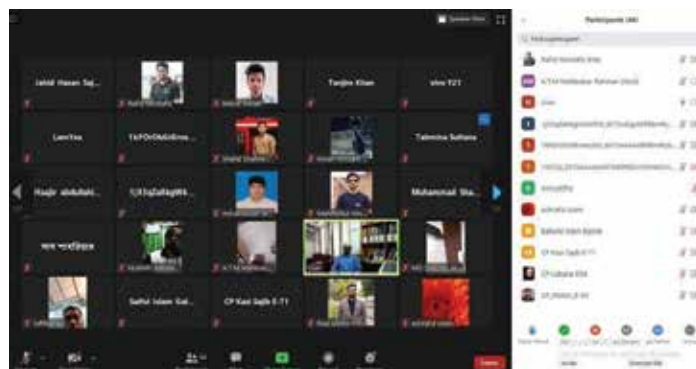


Fig.: Freshers reception program of Dept. of CSE 60th batch (1st shift) & 82nd batch (2nd shift).

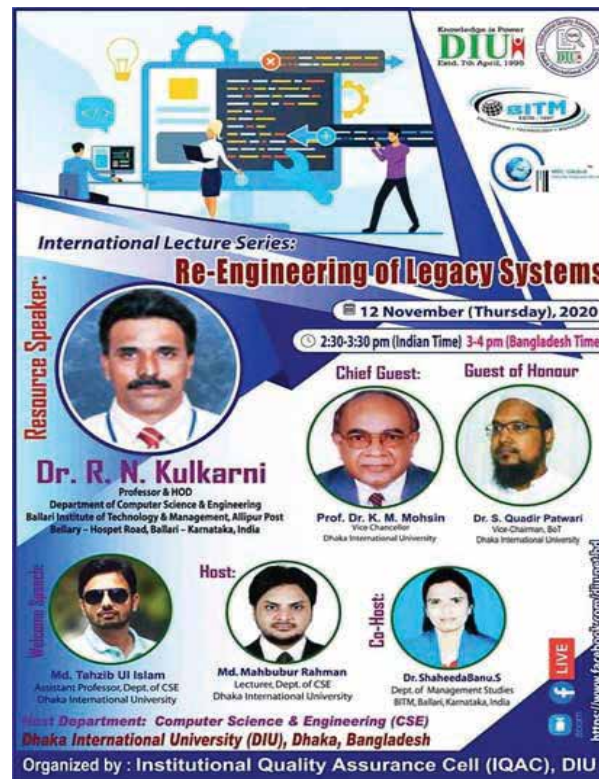


Fig.: International Lecture Series on Re-Engineering and Legacy System.

Tougher Tobacco Control Law Recommended for a Tobacco-free Bangladesh

Study Result Unveiled conducted by Dhaka International University

The existing tobacco control law lacks some of the major provisions from the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (WHO FCTC). In particular, the law contains provisions for smoking zones in public places and public transport, display of tobacco products at the points-of-sales and falls short of completely banning tobacco companies' corporate social responsibility (CSR) programs. These loopholes prevent the tobacco control law from playing a strong role in achieving a tobacco-free Bangladesh by 2040, as envisioned by the Honorable Prime Minister. Besides, an amendment of the law is a must to make it stronger and time-fitting and to reach the highest global standards. Such findings have come up in a study, titled Tobacco Control Laws in Bangladesh: Analysis of Gaps and Proposed Reforms, conducted by the Department of Law, Dhaka International University, with support from Campaign for Tobacco-free Kids (CTFK). The findings were unveiled on 07 December 2021, Tuesday during an event at the CIRDAP International Conference Centre, Dhaka.

The chief guest of the event was former Minister of Health and Family Welfare and the President of Bangladesh's Parliamentary Standing Committee on Science & Technology Dr. A.F.M. Ruhul Haque MP. The special guests included Ms. Vandana Shah, Regional Director of South Asia Programs of Campaign for Tobacco Free Kids (CTFK), USA, Kazi Zebunessa Begum, Additional Secretary (World Health), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Md. Mostafizur Rahman, Lead Policy Advisor, Campaign for Tobacco-Free Kids (CTFK), and Hossain Ali Khondokar, Additional Secretary and Coordinator National Tobacco Control Cell (NTCC), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and. The keynote paper was presented by Barrister Shameem Haider Patwary, Chairman of Board of Trustees, and President of Tobacco Control and Research Cell at Dhaka International University. Md. Bazlur Rahman, Associate Professor and Member Secretary of Tobacco Control and Research Cell of the university delivered the welcome speech and the event was presided over by Prof. Dr. Ganesh Chandra Saha, Vice-Chancellor (In-charge) of Dhaka International University.
